SANDY RUN REGIONAL PARK KEY PERMIT

The Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority (NVRPA) hereby permits _____ to have in his/her possession an entrance key to Sandy Run Regional Park for the sole purpose of entry to the park in accordance with the following conditions, and the policies, rules and regulations of the NVRPA:

1. The key holder will provide the Park Authority with a key deposit up to \$35.00 prior to the availability of a set of keys.
2. The key holder must be **18 years of age** or older to obtain a set of key and to sign this permit.
3. **The key holder will assume responsibility for the behavior of all persons s/he admits to the park. Entrance to the park is for rowing related activities only.**
4. The key holder will not lend park keys to others without express written permission of the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority.
5. The key holder **will not duplicate** any of the keys.
6. Sandy Run is closed December and January, and reopens February weather permitting. Access to Sandy Run when the park is closed is by appointment only with the park manager at 703-690-4392.
7. The key holder will use the entrance gate key for entering the park on weekdays from dawn until 2:00p.m., and on Saturdays and Sundays. During those times, the key holder will close the gate immediately after the vehicle passes through. The park ranger is responsible for admittance at other times.
8. On weekdays from 2 p.m. until dark, the entrance gate will be open for scholastic rowing programs in the spring and fall.
9. The key holder is responsible for locking **all buildings** when he or she is the last person to leave the park at any time of the day. The key holder is also responsible for locking the **front gate** when he or she is the last person to leave the park any time of the day and/or before dark.
10. The key holder must have permission from the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority to be in the park from dark until dawn.

11. The key holder will forfeit the deposit if the gate key is lost or stolen. To receive a second set of keys, a new deposit must be paid.
12. Any violation of these terms and/or park rules and regulations of NVRPA, the key holder will forfeit the deposit and turn in the keys.
13. The key holder understands that possession of an entrance key is a ***privilege, not a contractual right***, and the Park Authority reserves the right to demand return of the keys at any time.
